CODE OF ETHICS

General Principles:

1. CVMC members shall act with:
 - A. Integrity
 - B. Honesty
 - C. Trustworthiness
2. CVMC members shall maintain the highest standard of professional and personal conduct.

Duty to the Association:

1. CVMC members shall not use membership affiliation to secure personal privilege, gain, or benefit.
2. CVMC members shall not use membership affiliation against the interest of the association.
3. CVMC members shall not make false, misleading, or unwarranted statements, representations of claims in regard to association matters, nor shall they engage in false or deceptive practices.
4. CVMC members shall treat colleagues in a respectful fashion, mindful of individual differences.
5. Uphold all laws and regulations relating to association activities.
6. Maintain the confidentiality of privileged information.
7. Dissemination of information to association members and to the community at large relative to CVMC shall be subject to executive committee review.

Violation of Standards:

1. CVMC members not adhering to the Bylaws, Code of Ethics, or conduct not in the best interest of CVMC may be subject to actions up to revocation of association membership.
